Explain the significance of each.
6. What was the attitude of the people in exile? What was God's response? (12:21-28)
7. What was the message of the false prophets in Jerusalem and how was God going to remedy the situation? (13:1-16)
8. Who were the women who claimed to be prophetesses? What kinds of practices were they engaged in and what were the results of such practices? (13:17-23)
