5. What was the problem with Israel's shepherds? Who are Israel's shepherds? (34:1ff)
6. Who would be their new shepherd? What would he do that the former shepherds had not done? (34:1-31)
7. Who does Edom represent in Ezekiel 35? Compare and contrast what is said about Edom in chapter 35 with what is said about Israel in chapter 36. What is the point?
