Questions... From Psalm 62

1. How did David demonstrate his confidence in God in the face of danger?
2. What were the intentions of David's enemies?
3. Where did David find his sense of security if not in his own status or power?
4. What does it mean to "pour out your heart" to God?
5. What reasons did the psalm writer give people to put their trust in the Lord?
6. David concludes the psalm with the reminder that each person will be rewarded by God "according to what they have done" (TNIV). How does knowing that make you feel? (See Romans 2:6-8; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Matthew 16:27.)
