Questions... From Psalm 50

1. Read Psalm 50.
2. What impressions do you get about God and his power from verses 1-4? Make some notes that help you to describe God's power from things that you can see in his creation.
3. In verse 4, God is described as coming to judge his people. What are the implications of his coming judgment to those who don't accept him or don't know him? What responsibility do we have towards those people if we do accept him and know him?
4. What sacrifices are you making in your life? How are you making these sacrifices? With what kind of heart do you offer them?
5. Have you had any difficult times in your life? Why does God allow difficulty to happen to his people? What do you do during difficult times to get through them?
6. Who are the wicked? Do the wicked have anything to fear from God? Why does God allow evil to continue? Why does he continue to show patience towards it?
7. What is man's purpose on earth? What is he meant to do for God? See verse 23.
