Questions... From Psalm 59

1. Read Psalm 59.
2. Review I Samuel 19 for the story of how Saul trapped David in his own house. Does this story match the contents of the Psalm? How do you know this Psalm is related to this story?
3. Think of a circumstance where you felt that your privacy or your security was violated. Describe how this felt to you. How might this compare to how David felt?
4. What did David pray for? What should Christians today pray for when facing this same kind of trial?
5. How powerful is man? How powerful does man think that he is? What does God think of man's power (vs. 8)?
6. Describe how David relies on God in verses 8-17.
7. What lessons have you learned from studying how David relied on God?
